New Gardasil Vaccine Offered by the Cumberland County Health Department

Cumberland County Health Department is offering free Gardasil vaccine for adults and children under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) to prevent illnesses such as human papillomavirus (HPV), cervical cancer, and genital warts. Gardasil is provided on a first-come first served basis at various locations. To find out if you are eligible to receive the vaccines, please review the following criteria:

Gardasil (HPV)

- Prevents Human Papillomavirus (HPV), which causes cervical cancer in females and genital warts in both males and females
- Vaccine is given in a series of three (3) doses
- Vaccine recommended for males and females 9 to 26 years old
 - Ages 18-26 may attend the free STD clinic on Wednesdays at the Medical Arts Building on Manheim Ave in Bridgeton from 4pm-5pm
 - Ages 9-26 may call the Health Department at (856) 327-7602 for an appointment
