Point In Time Survey, Salem County, January 29th, 2008-

This survey is part of a national program to count the homeless across the country. As people who are homeless often move about (and even cross state lines from Camden to Philadelphia), this national survey is conducted on the same day for all locations. Volunteers are needed to assist the Inter-Agency Council with various activities that day including interviewing people who are homeless, working at service sites or making donations of coats, blankets, gloves, hats and toiletries for care packages. CSMRC training: It is very important that volunteers complete the application process and training modules. If you are not yet



approved, you are not allowed to participate in drills or events. You also will not receive important e-mails from our office or the state and national MRC offices. You may begin training once you apply and while we are waiting for you to send in the requested approval documents. You are allowed to participate in drills and events if approved and if certain areas of required training are completed. Our goal is to get all registered applicants approved and training completed by January 2008. Please remember to check NJLMN for courses as scheduled. These are free and many provide CEU's for physicians and nurses.

No Access To Internet At Home or Work ?

You can access the internet from public libraries for your MRC training. You need to be a registered user of the particular library and establish a free e-mail account (yahoo, gmail, hotmail, etc).

For Cumberland County Residents: Go to any library in the CLUES systems (Millville, Vineland, County College, Bridgeton Free Library or Cumberland County Library) for a free library card. You need proof of county residency. At the same time check the schedule for free computer training on how to use the internet. Sessions are scheduled at all locations. For Salem County Residents: Go to the Bookmobile Library base at 900 Route 45, Building 3, Pilesgrove, NJ . The base library is open 9A-7P, Monday through Friday and 9A to noon on Saturdays. For more information call 856-769-1082. In addition the following municipalities have libraries with free internet for their residents or for a low fee for non-residents: Elmer Boro (358-2014), Salem Free Public Library (935-0526, Pennsville Public Library (678-5473), Woodstown/Pilesgrove Public Library (769-0098) and the Penns Grove/Carneys Point Public Library (299-4255).
